

GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE KATIBA DAY.



The 2024 Katiba Day came at the height of conversations around the state of the Nation. with issues such as the Gen Z movement revolution, Leadership and Integrity, human rights revolving around police brutality orchestrated during the nationwide demonstrations, the question of sovereignty of the people, etc. The Katiba Day seminar was to be an avenue to assess the state of constitutional implementation, particularly chapter 6, based on the aspirations of Kenyans for a government based on the essential values of human rights, equality, freedom, democracy, social justice and the rule of law as enshrined in the preamble of the Constitution.

KCPF partnered with various organizations to commemorate the 14th anniversary of the promulgation of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010. These organizations included:

KATIBA DAY 2024 SEMINAR

This was held on 27th August 2024 at Ufungamano House. The theme of the event was "Leadership and Integrity: The Promise of the Kenya We Want."

The Chief Guest was the LSK President, Madam Faith Odhiambo. She gave a keynote speech on the theme, noting that the citizens have a very critical role in the push for constitutional implementation as leadership has been the greatest Achilles heel in the implementation of the Constitution.

We also had two panel discussions to shed light on governance issues. The first panel discussion was on the topic "State of the Nation: Reengaging the Bill of Rights and the Rule of Law." The panelists were SC Charles Kanjama, Dr. Oliver Muindi (CEO Uraia Trust) and Joshua Okayo (KSL President). They discussed the state of Kenya's constitutional implementation based on the aspirations of Kenyans in the preamble when they passed the Constitution in 2010.

It was noted that much is yet to be done with the political class showing no fidelity to the rule of law. Issues like freedom from torture, freedom of the media, right to assembly and to hold peaceful demonstrations, implementation of the two thirds gender rule, etc. are still to be fully realized. Ultimately, we need a united citizenry to push for adherence to the rule of law and full implementation of the Constitution

The second panel discussion was on the topic "Leadership and Integrity: Way forward towards full implementation of Chapter 6 of the Constitution." The Panelists were FCS Jeremiah Karanja (CEO ICS), Hon. Okiya Omtatah (Senator Busia) and Sheila Masinde (CEO TI Kenya). They noted that a foundational mistake had been made in 2013 when Uhuru Kenyatta and William Ruto were allowed to vie for presidency despite facing criminal charges at the ICC. They also interrogated the role of EACC, IEBC, ODPP and the church in promoting chapter 6 of the Constitution. They suggested tougher measures to be taken in punishing those found guilty as well as a moral reset for the Citizens so as to promote a culture of integrity in Kenya.


