# Kenya Christian Professionals Forum

## Introduction:

Greetings of goodwill and wishes of prosperity and good health from the Kenya Christian Professionals Forum [KCPF]. We hope you have been doing well. We have had an active calendar here at KCPF and we would like to share with you updates on our activities this year.

# Consultative Breakfast Meeting

At KCPF, we believe in empowering the society to be an impactful community advancing biblical values. Therefore, we provide professional and technical support in influencing the development of a legal and social environment that is supportive of biblical values in society through research, advocacy, mentorship and witnessing.

On Friday, 03rd and 10th March, 2023, we held a consultative breakfast meeting with church leaders to deliberate on the Supreme court ruling on LGBTQ (Supreme Court Petition No. 16 of 2019: NGO Board vs Eric Gitari & Others). The implication of the judgement is that it will open a way to the gradual dismantling of our legal, moral, and cultural prohibitions against homosexual behaviour, which is so destructive of the individual, families, communities, and the nation.

The main aim of the meeting was to form an awareness on the implications of the ruling and propose a solution to the nation's current situation. After a successful consultation, the team agreed on the following:

- Spiritual engagement- Prayers and various prayer initiatives.
- Petitions Parliament- Constitutional amendment, amendment of various laws.
- Retooling & capacity building-Equipping churches; partners and public to engage; support for families.
- Media Engagement-Building a resource centre; people who can take up to media.

# Life Symposium 2023

The changes taking place in our world today have enormous impacts on our lives, communities, and societies; the family being one such area where such changes are evidenced in manifold ways.

As part of raising awareness on the importance of Life, KCPF conducted a Life Symposium on 21st March 2023 at Daystar University with an aim to support and empower the society to thrive and take the responsibility to guard human life—at all of its stages—from those who would seek to harm it.

The theme for this year's Life Symposium was: Protecting life and family in challenging times.

Those in attendance were youth groups, students, church members and pro-life movements.
