FAMILY SYMPOSIUM

As part of the activities to mark the United Nations International Day of the Family (IDOF), KCPF in conjunction with the Family Consortium held a Family Symposium on Friday, 12th May, 2023 at CITAM Valley Road. The aim of the symposium was to equip and strengthen Christian professionals and church leaders with relevant knowledge on challenges facing the family, formulate strategies and mechanism to have the institution of family upheld and defended in our beloved country as the fundamental unit of Society (Article 45) as enshrined in the Constitution. It also presented an opportunity to explore the critical role of the church and Christian professionals in protecting and promoting the family.

Our Guest Speaker was Hon. Peter Kaluma who made a presentation on the LGBTQ attack on the family unit and advocated for the Family Protection Bill. Our panel discussion went on successfully as well in which a greater emphasize was put on Christian professionals and church leaders to protect and promote the family. Topics handled during the round table conversation were on **parenting, the LGBTQ ideology and media** of which we later climax in hearing the state of the family in Africa from various country representatives that were present.

This year's theme was "**Protecting Family Values in Changing Times.**"

POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAMME

On 15th May, 2023, KCPF participated in the launch of the National Positive Parenting Programme (NPPP) guideline and manual at Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development. The aim of the manual is to advocate for parents and caregivers’ schemes, religious, beliefs, practices and attitudes on parenting to strengthen the abilities of families and promote healthy child development.

Speaking at the event, Cabinet Secretary of Labour and Social Protection (CS) Florence Bore highlighted the problems affecting families as being drugs and substance abuse, digital online technology which is ever-present in this contemporary world of today under no parental guidance and care.

She also revealed that she is in collaboration with stakeholders to begin the journey of developing a national positive parenting programme. This will be delivered through existing structures under National, County governments all the way to the Sub County and constituency through the services of well-trained social development officers, counsellor volunteers and child protection volunteers to use on existing support system services provided by the community for families.
