What Breaks Your Heart?

It's easy to get discouraged by what's going on in the world. Almost everywhere we look, we see conflict, criticism, confusion, and chaos. There is no shortage of opportunities to point fingers, grow bitter, or give up. But a kingdom-oriented mind sees something else: plenty of opportunities to engage. There's perhaps no better time than right now to stand out.

Many believers wonder how. In a world with so many needs, you can't invest your life in all of them. Which ones are God calling you to meet? What breaks your heart? Which cause gets under your skin? What stirs you up? That will tell you a lot about how God is leading you to invest your life.

Nehemiah's heart broke when he received news from Jerusalem (Neh. 1:4). Things were going great in his own life—he held a good position as the Persian king's cup bearer—but the Jewish exiles who had returned to Jerusalem to rebuild it were suffering, and God's purposes were not being fulfilled. The walls of the city were broken, the people were discouraged and harassed by enemies, and God's promise that the temple would be restored to its former glory seemed lost.
