Your Gender Is God's Good Design

Today, in a complex world governed by strong national interests and goals, the ethical witness of faith is of growing importance. When the Son of God took on a human nature, He underlined forever the dignity and value of human embodiment, because He shared it—and still does. He did not leave His human nature behind; He is still fully human and fully God, seated at the right hand of the Father.

Furthermore, He affirms sexed human embodiment—that is, being female or male. Jesus did not appear in His resurrection as an androgynous being but as He had been in His earthly life: as a male. Additionally, God's creation of humanity embodied as male and female was indeed very good (Gen 1:28, 31).

We can humbly and confidently believe that God created humanity good as male and female while we relate with kindness and respect to people who do not believe this. It is not surprising that people who do not follow Jesus as King also do not always follow what He says about their bodies. There is much confusion today.

Our enemies are not human beings but spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places (Eph 6:12). We should seek the opportunity to listen well to our friends who are different than us, humbly imploring them to be reconciled to God through Christ (2 Cor 5:20).
