STATEMENT OF FAITH

KCPF is guided by the following:

1. Biblical Christianity with commitment and obedience to the teaching of Jesus Christ, the Son of God (*Sermon on the Mount, Matthew 5-7*);
2. KCPF is ecumenical and believes in the unity of the body of Christ (*John 17:21*);
3. Sanctity of life from conception to natural death (*John 10:10*);
4. Upholding the natural family as the building block of society and as established by God. (*Matthew 19:4-6*);
5. Promotion of values-based education of children and the right of parents to remain the authority over their children's lives before they reach the age of majority (*Proverbs 22:6*);
6. Freedom of religion and religious practice including freedom to change religion, freedom for any religion or denomination to establish, manage and operate their own institutions without undue interference. And support for the Christian religion (*Great Commission, Matthew 28:19-20*); and
7. Good governance of the state, local communities and organisations, good citizenship and social justice with respect to honor for human dignity, equality, and the realization of human potential (*Isaiah 1:17; Matthew 22: 39*);

STATEMENT OF VALUES
